The reason for producing the pamphlet:

The advocacy committee of Professional Surveyors Canada (PSC) were made aware of concerns about the unintentional and in some cases deliberate destruction of survey monuments. These concerns came from many jurisdictions across Canada. As years go by the destruction of these monuments leads to the erosion of the survey fabric in Canada. As all surveyors know the maintenance and of preservation of the survey fabric is vital to the economic wellbeing of Canada.

Pamphlet Distribution:

The following is a list of suggested places to distribute the pamphlet. The list is not exhaustive and PSC would appreciate any feedback on other places for distribution.

- provincial government offices
- local municipal authorities responsible for land/road development

Layout and modification of the Pamphlet:

The pamphlet is provided free of charge in PDF format and should be printed on both sides of an 8 ½ x 11 sheet of paper in landscape mode. The panels are setup so that the sheet can be folded into a tri-fold pamphlet.

Since this pamphlet is meant to be used in most, if not all, jurisdictions in Canada it was deliberately made to be as generic as possible. When the pamphlet is folded you will notice that there is one section left blank. This blank section becomes the back panel of the pamphlet. This was deliberately left blank so that survey companies, individual surveyors and associations can add their contact information.
